February will be an exciting month at DMWS—visits from both the Storyteller and the Book Mobile, a canned food drive to benefit Urban Ministries of Durham, and Valentine's Day Celebrations! Carpool Reminders

Safety is very important to us at DMWS. Our carpool line is designed to safely and efficiently help your children enter and exit school. We encourage you to use carpool line daily, but if you do choose to park in the lot on Memorial Drive and walk your child in, we ask that you follow these basic safety rules. Remember Memorial Drive is a city street and many cars use it daily. U-turns on Memorial Drive are not safe.

- + Always hold hands with your child when crossing the street.
- + Always use the crosswalk.
- + During morning carpool, watch for a signal from the crossing guard before crossing the street. In an effort to avoid gridlock, we ask pedestrians to cross in groups and cars to exit carline in groups.

The paved parking lot has several spaces along the back fence marked with RESERVED signs. Please do not park in those spots. Also, the paved lot has three places to enter/exit. The center one is for exiting and the outer two are for entering. Note that the parking spaces are aligned to this traffic pattern.

Please help us by prominently displaying your carpool tag from your rearview mirror. This will help us keep the line moving.

Some families choose to walk up to pick up your child at the end of the school day. Walk-ups will be handled at the end of carline. Remember that pick-up is noon for most students. Kindergarten students and children staying for Lunch Bunch have a 12:50pm pick-up time. The late pick-up fee is \$10.

Mark your calendars for DMWS Summer Camp! This summer, DMWS will offer 2 weeks of camp this summer. You will be able to sign up for one or two weeks. Week 1 will be June 24-28. Registration Information for 2019-2020

Registration for next year begins on January 30. In order to hold a spot for 2019-2020 at the time of registration, you will pay a registration fee of \$75 for returning students (\$85 for new students). All registration fees are non-refundable.

During Parent Conferences on January 28 and 29, you will receive an application for each of your currently enrolled children. Applications for siblings will be available in the office. Priority for registration is as follows:

Wednesday, January 30: Registration opens

Thursday, February 7: Initial Registration deadline (you must meet this deadline to retain your priority in the registration process)

Monday, February 11: Notification of Class Assignment

Tuesday, February 19: Facilities fee of \$50 plus one month's tuition due (tuition credited to May 2020). After this payment, your child's spot is secured for next year. This payment is also non-refundable.

Tuition rates for 2019-2020 have been approved by the DMWS Board of Directors.

A 10% discount is given to younger siblings.
