DMWS Summer Camp 2021

Mark your calendars for DMWS Summer Camp! This summer, DMWS will offer 3 weeks of camp this summer. You will be able to sign up for one, two or three weeks. Week 1 will be June 21-25. Week 2 will be July 12-16 and Week 3 will be August 2-6 from 9am-12:30pm. Campers will enjoy a variety of activities including daily music and fitness opportunities. Tuition for camp is \$180 per week. Camp is open to rising 3's through rising first graders. Applications have been sent home in your child's folder.

Tuition Assistance

DMWS is able to offer tuition assistance to families who demonstrate need. Yearlong assistance applications are due by May 1 of each school year while emergency assistance applications may be submitted as the need arises. Applicants may pick up applications in the school office. The DMWS Board of Directors determines recipients at the May board meeting. All applications/awards are kept confidential.
