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Important Registration Information for 2022-2023

Registration for next year begins on January 26. In order to hold a spot for 2022-2023 at the time of registration, you will pay a registration fee of \$75 for returning students (\$85 for new students). **All registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.**

During the week of January 18-21, you will receive an application for each of your currently enrolled children through their school folder. Applications for siblings may be requested from the office. Priority for registration is as follows:

In order to retain priority, your completed application must be received by the February 4th deadline.

Tuition rates for 2022-2023 will be set by our Board of Directors in December.

DMWS Tuition Payments

Tution payments are due each month on the first and past due on the tenth. Payment options. Include check, cash, credit card (on-line via website) and automatic draft. Checks and cash payments are encouraged because our school does incur additional fees to process the credit card and ACH payments.

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Remind Texting Service
