Happy March! This month we will enjoy St. Patrick's Day festivities and many spring activities. We will have a tornado drill this month and a fire drill. The teachers make sure to prepare the children before we do emergency drills so they know what to expect.

## DMWS Summer Camp 2022- Applications Available!

Mark your calendars for DMWS Summer Camp! This summer, DMWS will offer 3 weeks of camp. Week 1 will be June 20-24. Week 2 will be July 11-15 and Week 3 will be July 25-29 from 9am-12:30pm. Campers will enjoy a variety of activities including daily music and fitness opportunities. All campers bring a lunch and DMWS provides snack. Tuition for camp is \$185 per week. Camp is open to rising 3's through rising first graders. Applications have been distributed through your child's school folder.

## **Tuition Assistance**

DMWS is able to offer tuition assistance to families who demonstrate need. Yearlong assistance applications are due by May 1 of each school year while emergency assistance applications may be submitted as the need arises. Applicants may pick up applications in the school office. The DMWS Board of Directors determines recipients at the May board meeting. All applications/awards are kept confidential.
