#### DID YOU KNOW?

Hand and wrist strengthening activities are vital for young children as they develop pre-writing skills. X-rays of children show that many bones in a preschooler's wrist are mostly cartilage. Strengthening muscles and tendons is important for children as they grow. Here are some great activities for you to do with your children to promote their development in this area.

- Playdough
- Paper tearing
- Poking holes in things (toothpicks work great!)
- Digging in dirt/sand
- Gluing
- Squeezing (stress balls or sponges)
- Painting (with brushes or Q-tips)
- Coloring
- Cutting
- Beading
- Building with blocks
- Throwing balls
